

Importing a Citation from PubMed

1. Within a PubMed citation, click on the **Send To** drop down menu
2. Select **File**
3. Change the **Format** drop down menu to **MEDLINE**
4. Click on **Create File**
5. Select where you want to save the file and click on **Save**
6. Open EndNote
7. Open or create a library
8. Click on the **Import** button or go to File->Import...
9. Click on the **Choose File** button
10. **Browse** to where you saved the file and click on **Open**
11. From the Import Option drop down menu, select **Other Filters...** and find **PubMed (NLM)** from the list and click on the **Choose** button
12. Click on the **Import** button
13. A list of the citations you imported will appear
14. Close the box to save

Importing a Citation from the Cochrane Library

1. Within the Cochrane Library database, select the records you wish to download
2. At the bottom of the page click on **Export Selected Citations**
3. Change the Export Type drop down menu to **Citation and Abstract**
4. Click on **Go**
5. When prompted, **Save** the file of references
6. Select where you want to save the file and name it
7. Open EndNote
8. Open or create a library
9. Click on the **Import** button or go to File->Import...
10. Click on the **Choose File** button
11. **Browse** to where you saved the file and click on **Open**
1. From the Import Option drop down menu, select **Other Filters...** and find **Cochrane Library (Wiley)** from the list and click on the **Choose** button

2. Click on the **Import** button
3. A list of the citations you imported will appear
4. Close the box to save

Importing a Citation from Agricola

1. Within the Agricola database, open a reference you wish to import
2. Under Print, Save or Email select **Export Format**
3. Click on **Format for Click or Save**
4. Go to **File** and **Save As**
5. Change the type to a **text file (*.txt)** and save the file
6. Open EndNote
7. Open or create a library
8. Click on the **Import** button or go to File->Import...
9. Click on the **Choose File** button
10. **Browse** to where you saved the file and click on **Open**
11. From the Import Option drop down menu, select **Other Filters...** and find **Agricola (NAL)** from the list and click on the **Choose** button
12. Click on the **Import** button
13. A list of the citations you imported will appear
14. Close the box to save
