### **Electronic Resource of the Month - images.MD**

Because medicine is a visual science, high-quality images are an important aid in diagnosis and teaching. Images.MD compiles over 70,000 high-quality images spanning all specialties of internal medicine. All images in images.MD are taken from Current Medicine Group LLS's series of illustrated atlases. As new atlases are published or existing series updated, images.MD delivers these updates to its subscribers. Each image is accompanied by detailed and informative text written by over 2,000 contributing experts. Users may register for a "My Slides" free account, which allows images to be saved for future use. "My Slides" allows users to create slide sets, PowerPoint presentations, and customized CDs.

Images.MD is available from the library's **Electronic Resources** page under "Article Searching and Databases". Databases are listed in alphabetical order.
