New bibliographic database available: EMBASE

EMBASE.com is a biomedical database containing more than 18 million bibliographic records. Included are more than 11 million EMBASE records from 1974-present and over 7 million unique Medline records from 1966-present. More than 7,000 journals from over 70 countries are indexed, 2,000 more journals than covered by EMBASE or Medline individually. EMBASE.com's strengths are coverage and extensive indexing of the drug and pharmacology literature and their international journal coverage and indexing.

Topics covered in EMBASE are:

- Drug research, pharmacology, pharmacy, pharmacoeconomics, pharmaceuticals and toxicology
- Human Medicine
- Basic biological research
- Health policy and management
- Public, occupational and environmental health
- Substance dependence and abuse
- Psychiatry
- Forensic science
- Biomedical engineering and instrumentation
