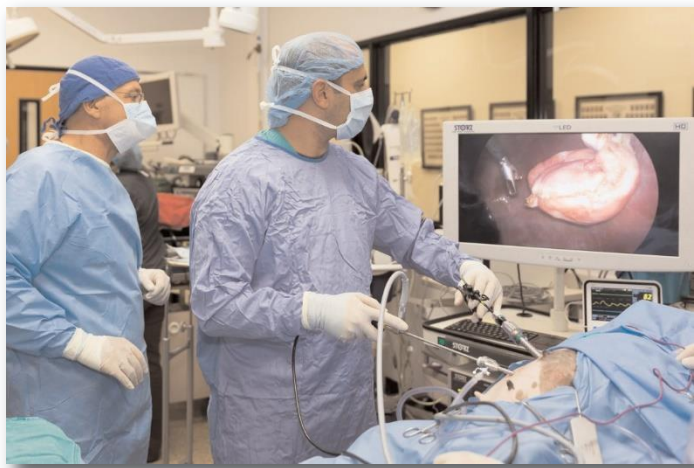
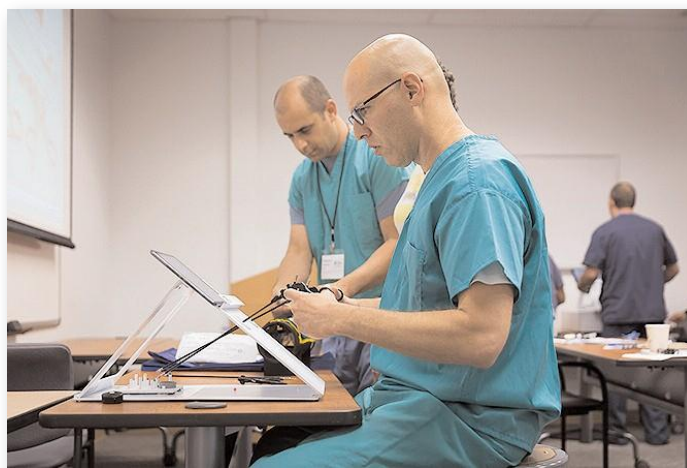


# LAPAROSCOPY COURSE FOR SMALL ANIMAL VETERINARY PRACTITIONERS
