IPE Review <i>Dr. John Tegzes</i>	<p>Dr. Tegzes is the Director of Interprofessional Education. How do you see where IPE is leading and how would you like to see that relate to WesternU?</p> <p>IPE is criticized across the University because the program occurred so quickly and required a lot of effort from a lot of people across all nine programs and the outcomes seem rather unclear still.</p> <p>There are now accreditation standards for IPE and all nine programs at WesternU. We have two national committees that are creating standardized objectives and outcomes for IPE that they are asking all the professions to adhere to and to take on within their curricula and that are influencing the accreditation standards. Not only do all nine programs here have accreditation standards, they are changing and now the bar has been raised. USMLE steps 1, 2, 3 have content specific outlines for interprofessional learning. Dr. Tegzes wants WesternU to measure outcomes in both the learners and faculty. To keep raising the bar for what could happen</p>			

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	<p>at a national level. He would like to see the program evolve, the program mature as well as teaching methods. To get better training across the faculty for what it means to do small group teaching and learning. The goal is to move the faculty forward to help with small group teaching.</p> <p><i>Form COMPs perspective, there are a few things they are concerned about, IPE is assessing the students satisfaction but how is the students satisfaction being disseminated? Dr. Susan Mackintosh is the representative on the implementation committee and it is her job to disseminate it back to COMP.</i></p> <p><i>There is a concern that the Faculty can govern IPE and how its developed.</i></p>
