RWC Electrical System Upgrade

Phase-1&2, Electrical Room Upgrade & Exterior Site Utility

Construction Timeframe

<u>Phase-1 Electrical Room Upgrade</u> Wednesday 3/22/2023 thru Friday 10/27/2023

<u>Phase-2 Site Utilities Upgrade</u> Estimating August/September 2023 start

Capital Planning & Construction is upgrading the Electrical system at RWC. This will consist of 2-phases for a New Electrical room location & afterwards exterior underground conduit and cabling to newly installed City Distribution Transformer.

Phasing eliminates any current power interruption to RWC and operations during normal business hours. Once both phases are complete, a 1-day power switchover to new electrical system will be coordinated at that time.

Phase-1 will be construciton of new enclosure at 1st Floor for larger Electrical component Install, to distribute & handle improved electrical demands.

Phase-2 when it later occurs, will consist of trenching and digging up a portion of the Parking lot behind RWC, AAC & Former bookstore's south drive asile (closest to Bldg). Traffic coordination map and information an any other lot impacts will be provided at that time. Construction start based on equipment availability/arrival.

Safety First. In continual efforts to keep our campus safe, all External Contractors & Vendors are provided with Covid-19 guidelines & PPE regulations. Use of PPE is monitored and enforced for any work/Access to indoor common spaces. This is monitored and enforced during supervision visits.

HOW THIS AFFECTS UNIVERSITY

A construction fence will be installed to take up half the Driveway adjacent to Construction area along Gibbs St. and rear sidewalk at back corner of RWC.

Parking Stalls at back corner of RWC will be reserved for Construction use. 6 additional stalls at Centenial Park will be made available for Contractor use and may be coned off during this time (Student & reserved stalls will not be impacted).

Existing RWC Electrical room is located within a **Lab area**. We will coordinate with Research for any access needs through the space for minimal disruptions.

Contractor workflow: Construction hours will be 6am – 2pm. Occasional 5am start to minimize loud construction noise during operating hours.
