



1. When do I need to physically be in Lebanon?

You must be in Lebanon in time for Orientation, which is scheduled the first week of July. Classes will start early July.

2. What are my housing and roommate options?

Please review WesternU's <u>list of current housing options in Lebanon</u>. There are additional buildings not listed and/or are under construction that you may be able to find through external websites. There are also housing options in surrounding towns, such as Albany and Corvallis. These communities are 30 minutes or less from Lebanon but may be a bit pricier. In terms of roommates, we have several virtual events planned in the next few months where you can meet your future classmates, exchange contact information, and discuss living arrangements.
