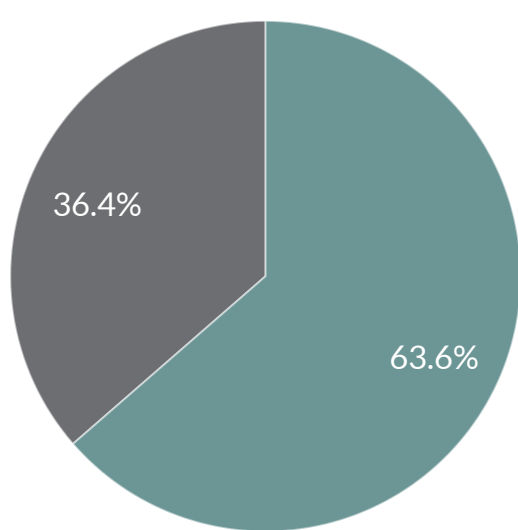
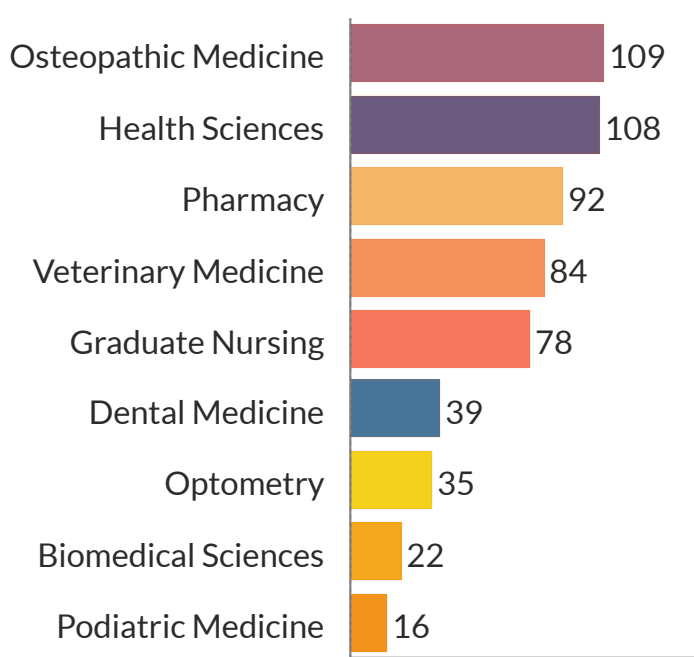

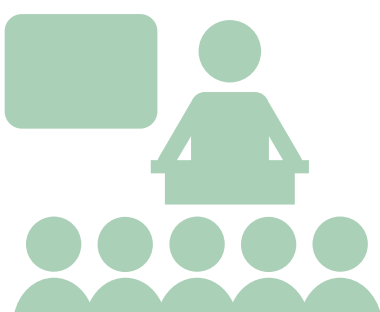
Respondents by College

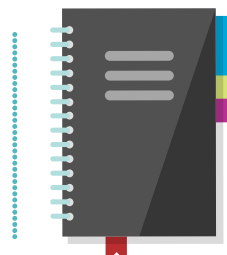

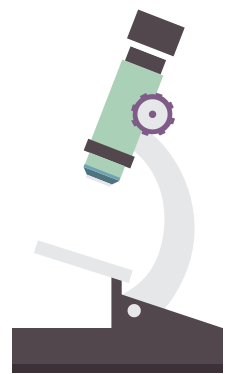
