Welcome and Opening Remarks	<ul> <li>Dr. Bradley Henson welcomed attendees, emphasizing the importance of this initiative and thanking everyone for their commitment. He highlighted that this diverse committee will collaboratively ensure content and voice reflect the university's mission and evolving WSCUC standards. The committee's work will be evidence-driven and aligned with university goals.</li> </ul>
Introductions	All attendees introduced themselves.
Steering Committee Overview	Dr. Siegel provided a summary via PowerPoint:

	<ul> <li>The Steering Committee will guide the university through the WSCUC accreditation process, with Dr. Henson as ALO, Dr. Siegel as chair, Heather Simmons providing administrative support, and Carl Todaro handling technical assistance.</li> <li>WesternU's governance is represented through five branches, with plans to add more committee members.</li> <li>A timeline for the accreditation process was presented.</li> <li>Dr. Tamela Hawley, WesternU's WSCUC Liaison, will conduct a 2.5-hour training session.</li> </ul>
WesternU Accreditation Overview	Dr. Siegel provided background on WesternU's accreditation history.
WSCUC 2023 Handbook and Standards	<ul> <li>Dr. Siegel highlighted recent updates to WSCUC standards.</li> <li>Plans to invite a WSCUC Liaison to provide additional training.</li> <li>Reviewed slides on the new 2023 Handbook and recent updates to the accreditation process.</li> <li>Emphasis on integrating DEI across all four standards as a significant recent change.</li> <li>Question: Dr. Cornish inquired about DEI alignment given recent SCOTUS rulings.</li> <li>Response: Dr. Henson noted the need to frame the DEI narrative within the context of recent legal changes, ensuring compliance.</li> <li>Legal Compliance: Dr. Bowlin confirmed the university's legal department has reviewed and aligned with the "Wisdom Plan" to ensure compliance.</li> </ul>
