



2019 Global Quality and Safety Fellowship Chitkara University-Global Week

The College of Graduate Nursing became the recipient of the Fletcher Jones Endowment Program in 2014. This endowment provides funds that can support quality and safety initiatives to improve quality and safety within and between systems along the health care continuum locally and globally. To uphold the College of Graduate Nursing's commitment to high quality, safe health and healthcare for individuals, populations, and communities; we are pleased to offer the following CGN Global Quality and Safety Fellowship for MSN and DNP students.

Focus of fellowship

- Partner with Chitkara University, Chandigarh, India; an international partner site and engage with nurses, faculty and students to facilitate the following:
 - Development of leadership competencies for quality and safety
 - Systems-based interprofessional approach to improve quality and safety for vulnerable population

Amount to be awarded

- \$2000 stipend to cover travel expenses

Global Quality and Safety Fellows will:

- Complete all identified clinical activities including pre-trip preparation, identification of interventions/outcomes and implementation of education program.
- Participate in post-trip debrief session.
- Disseminate work and outcomes achieved to WesternU, or clinical/practice site, or professional conference. This is to be completed by the end of Spring 2020.

Fellowship Criteria:

- Applicants of this fellowship must be a current MSN, DNP, Post MSN FNP Certificate student; maintain a GPA of 3.5 and above. Must have an active RN license.
- Completion of Global Quality and Safety Fellowship application that addresses:
 - Commitment to vulnerable populations and health system quality and safety
 - Ability to be a CGN ambassador to the international community
- Resume

The application has the following sections:

1. Personal Statement: Should not exceed one-page, single space, 12-font
2. Short-answer questions: Should not exceed two pages, single space, 12-font
3. Complete application should not exceed three pages, single space, 12-font.
4. Resume

Selection and Award Process:

Complete applications will be evaluated by Fletcher Jones Endowed Chair for Nursing Quality and Safety, Program Director, and Assistant Dean of Global Health and Community Engagement.

A scoring rubric will be used to evaluate your personal statement, project proposal, and resume. The applications with the highest total scores will be selected for this award.

All award recipients will be notified by August 15.
