WUCO graduate, **Dr. Judy Cao** (OD 2014), is opening her new practice on March 27, 2019 in the city of San Gabriel. We are so proud!

Dr. Bennett McAllister took **seven first year students** to the Blind Center of Nevada on March 16th. The clients of the Blind Center need annual blindness certifications for their grants to continue and having WUCO come to their Center reduces hardships on each person getting to a doctor on their own. All 34 patients seen were certified legally blind. A sampling of the etiologies: diabetic retinopathy, retinopathy of prematurity, retinitis pigmentosa, strokes, car accident trauma, intimate partner violence, genetic disorder, glaucoma, macular degeneration, phthisis and more. This concentrated experience gives most first year students an introduction into the visual impairment field of optometry and shows them how they can help, even if the patient is legally blind.
