

OSCP accepts reports of misconduct/professionalism through the [WesternU Student of Concern Referral](#) form from any individual, regardless of their affiliation with the University. Referrals must be submitted using the designated referral [link](#) and cannot be made anonymously.

Once a referral is received, the OSCP reviews the information provided and may request additional details from the individual who submitted the referral or from other University or college offices to better understand the reported concerns. Based on the scope of the incident, some reports of misconduct/professionalism may be referred to other compliance offices within the University as well as the student's college Student Performance Committee (SPC).

Based on the nature and circumstances of the reported conduct or professionalism concern, the student may be:

- Referred to their college for professionalism counseling or coaching; or
- Referred to the Office of Student Conduct and Professionalism for resolution through either an Administrative Hearing or a Student Conduct Hearing Panel (SCHP).

Only student respondents who receive sanctions through the Student Conduct Hearing Panel (SCHP) process can appeal those sanctions to the Office of Student Appeals.
