

RECRUITING DOGS FOR CLINICAL EVALUATION OF SURGERY

Is your dog's knee hurting? ARE YOU LOOKING FOR A COST-EFFECTIVE SURGERY?

Is your dog a healthy adult weighing less than 120 lbs and is only troubled by a Cranial Cruciate Ligament Disease (CCLD) on one knee? **If so, we may be able to treat your pet with a suture repair for \$200, refunded at the end of follow-ups.**



We are studying a cost-effective, simple, and minimally invasive surgery to treat CCLD in dogs. The surgery has been sufficiently validated to allow its use in affected pets.
