Who is Eligible?

Any student may consult with CDHP at the Pomona or Lebanon campus to determine eligibility to receive accommodations and/or services.

Disability categories include but are not limited to:

- Physical
- Psychological
- Environmental/chemical
- Hearing
- Learning
- Chronic Illness
- Speech
- Vision



Accommodations

Students seeking CDHP assistance are assessed for needs, accommodations, and services which may include but are not limited to:

- Academic modifications
- Test accommodations
- Physical Access/ architectural modifications
- Note-taker accommodations
- Special furniture
- Auxiliary aids
- Disability management advising

Confidentiality and Privacy

The university recognizes that student records for the purpose of disability documentation, determination, and accommodation are confidential, as per state and federal laws.

Students requesting accommodations sign a Registration Agreement form which acknowledges that in order for CDHP to coordinate, advise, or administer requested accommodations, disclosure of disability information to faculty or appropriate administrators/staff may be necessary or required.
