Drug Convictions & Federal Student Aid

The Financial Aid Office is required to inform you upon enrollment at Western University of Health Sciences if you are convicted for any offense, during a period of enrollment for which you receive Title IV, Higher Education Act (HEA) Federal Student Aid (whether grants, loans or federal work-study), under any federal or state law involving the possession or sale of illegal drugs will result in the loss of eligibility for any Title IV, HEA program funds, grants, loans or federal work-study assistance (HEA Se.484(r)(1)); (20 U.S.C. 109(r)(1)).

The loss of eligibility will seriously affect the completion of your education.
