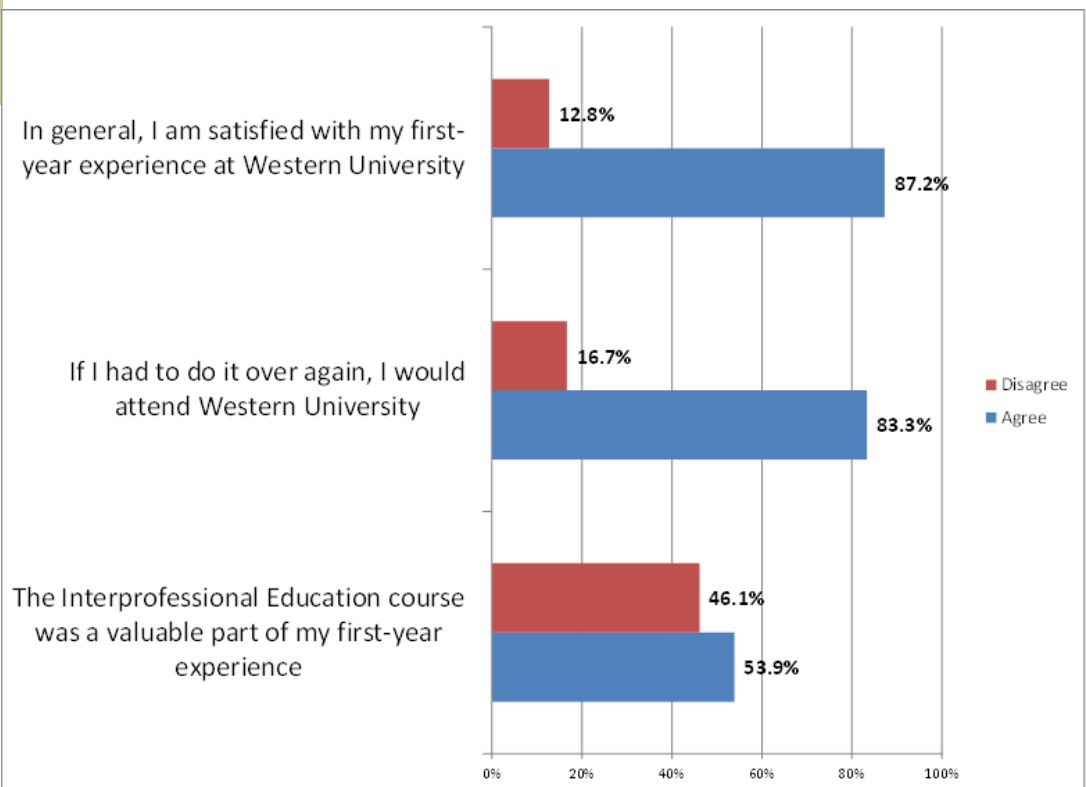

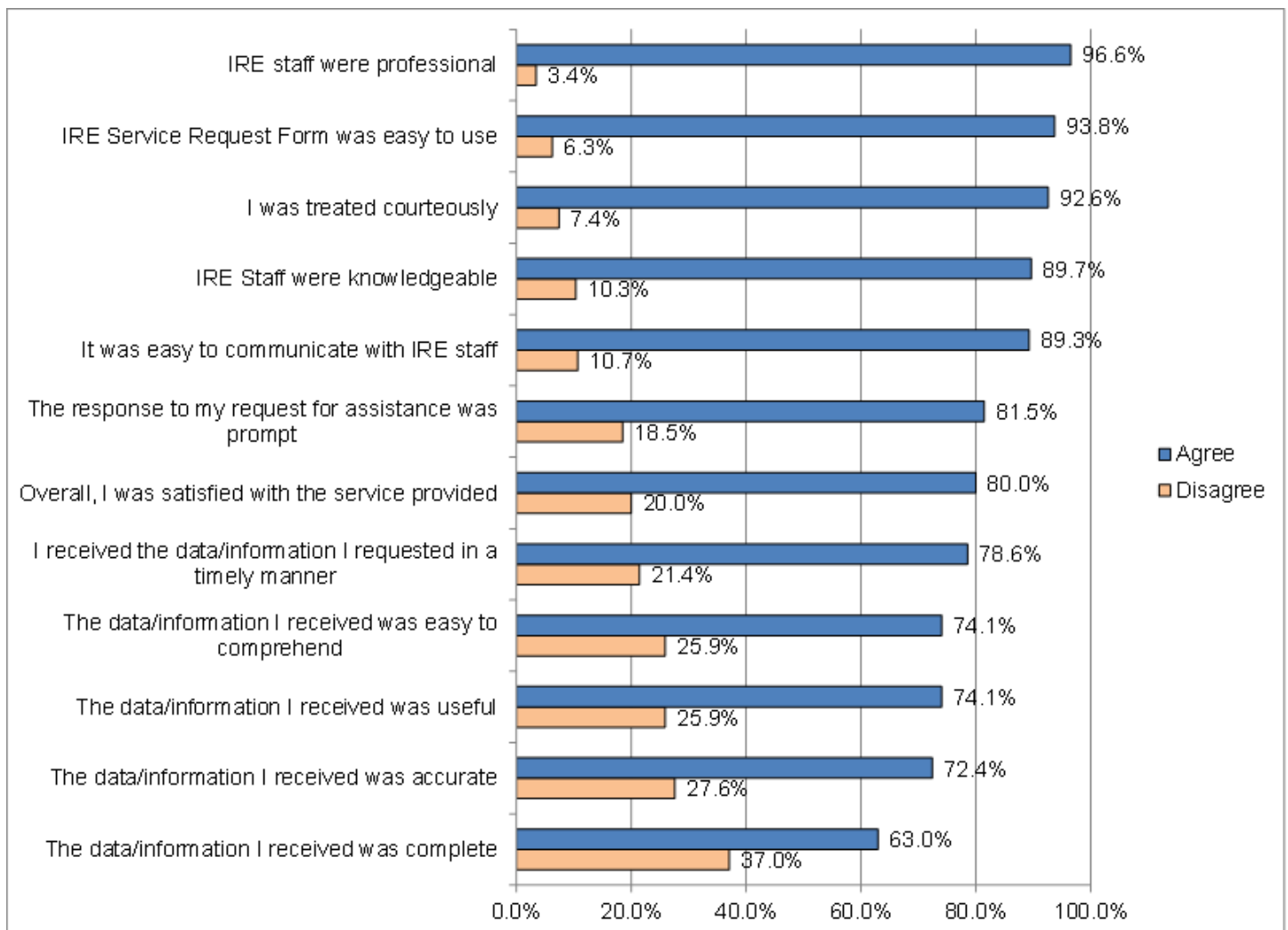
Results from IRE Customer Satisfaction Survey 2012

The IRE department conducted an online survey evaluating our services in fall of 2012. WesternU faculty and staff were invited to complete the survey – thank you to everyone who participated.

Survey results revealed that IRE strengths (see chart below) consist of professionalism and courteous treatment from staff and ease of use of the IRE Service Request Form. Limitations included low agreement ratings on receiving useful, accurate, and complete data.

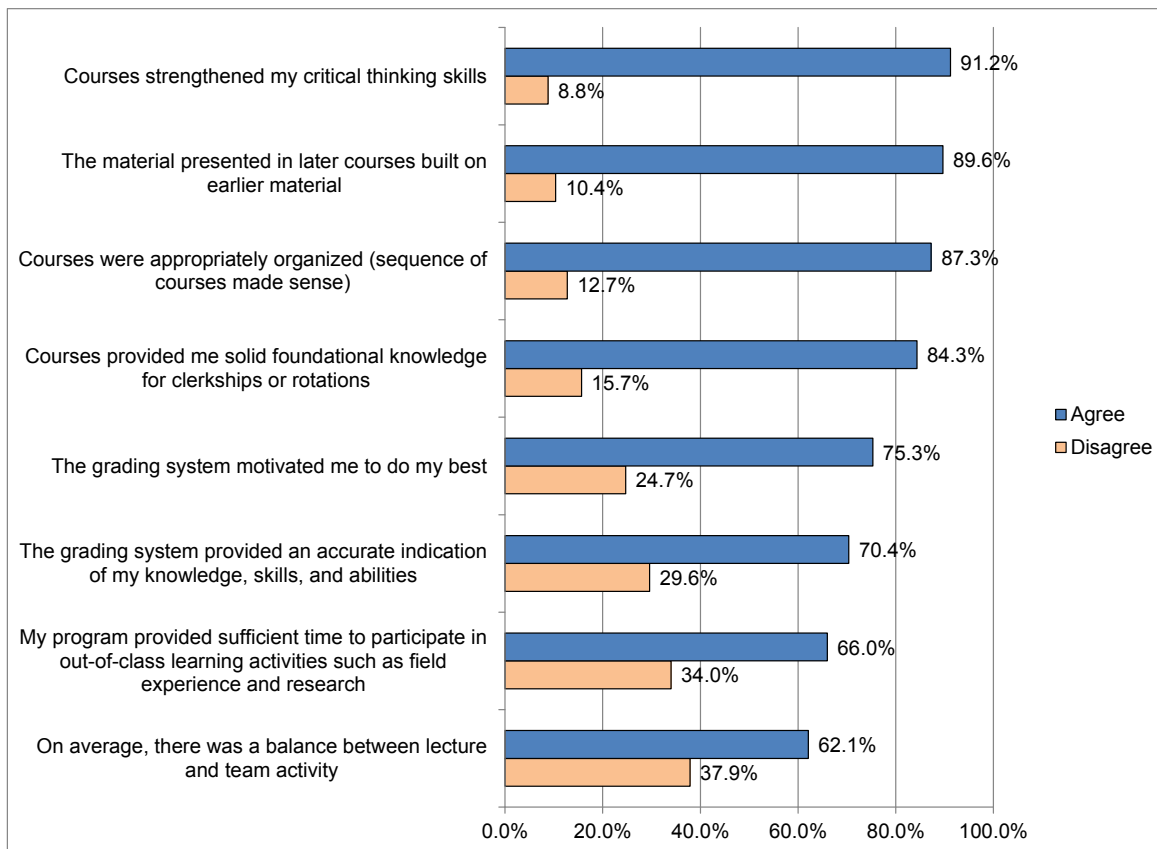
The IRE department has taken these findings into serious consideration and are currently working on ways to improve our services. Steps to be taken to address these issues:

- Ensuring that data definitions, headings, and titles clearly explain information on all charts and tables
- Development of an IRE service request communication protocol to ensure that client needs are clearly understood
- Increasing communication with clients throughout the service request
- Assisting with maintenance of institutional data standards to ensure consistency of measures
- Continuing to seek out best practices for maintaining data integrity
